Dear Customers

Important notice – Combe Martin Outfall concrete repair works

Essential improvement work required to repair the defective concrete casing on our sewerage network to the existing outfall pipe on the beach foreshore.

Access to the beach will be maintained as will residential parking and parking at Kiln Car Park. Access to Kiln Car Park will be as normal other than when the short diversion route at Cross Street starts on the 19th November for approximately 4 weeks to accommodate the surface water drainage separation works. The beach will not be closed but please be aware of ongoing work activities within and restrictions to the outfall pipe while the repairs are undertaken.

What's happening?

Our contractors, R&M Utilities, will be working in this area as from Monday 5th November 2018 until Friday 21 December 2018 approximately. Work activities on the beach will be via the slipway and can only proceed during periods on the following low tidal windows

05th Nov to 13th Nov
19th Nov to 28th Nov
03rd Dec to 13th Dec
18th Dec to 21st Dec

The work remit is to repair sections of defective concrete on the existing outfall pipe along the beach and foreshore pathway. Plant machinery and equipment will operate from the designated site compound on Marine Drive (the top of Kiln Car Park), transferring material onto the beach via the slipway. Premixed concrete will occasionally be delivered direct to the slipway and all safety control measures will be put into place to safeguard the public and local residents.

I would like to apologise for any inconvenience this may cause you and thank you for your patience whilst we complete this work.
