

## **Combe Martin Beach**

South West Water (SWW) will shortly be carrying out essential work to repair the defective concrete casing on the outfall pipe on the foreshore of Combe Martin Beach. Work is due to commence on Monday 5 November 2018 for approximately two months.

The beach will not be closed, but access to certain areas of the beach including the slipway, concrete ramp, and the outfall pipe may, at times, have restrictions in place. Plant machinery and equipment will be operating across the beach from Kiln Car Park and Cross Street via the slipway. Please be aware of work activities when using the beach and car park.

### **Details of the Work**

SWW contractors, R&M Utilities, will be working on the beach from Monday 5<sup>th</sup> November 2018 until Friday 21 December 2018. Work activities can only proceed during periods on the following low tidal windows:

05<sup>th</sup> Nov to 13<sup>th</sup> Nov

19<sup>th</sup> Nov to 28<sup>th</sup> Nov

03<sup>rd</sup> Dec to 13<sup>th</sup> Dec

18<sup>th</sup> Dec to 21<sup>st</sup> Dec

The work remit is to repair sections of defective concrete on the existing outfall pipe along the beach and foreshore. Plant machinery and equipment will operate from the designated site compound on Marine Drive (top of Kiln Car Park) transferring material onto the beach via the slipway. Premixed concrete will occasionally be delivered direct to the slipway and all safety control measures will be put into place to safeguard the public and local residents.
